NMCS D CORPSMAN SELECTED AS NAVY MEDICINE WEST SAILOR OF THE YEAR

SAN DIEGO — Every year, each Navy command selects their Sailor of the Year. These Sailors represent the platinum standard by which other Sailors are measured. They are the shining examples for the rest of the fleet to see and strive to emulate.



Hospital Corpsman 1st Class (Surface Warfare/Aviation Warfare) Monica M. Reeves, a native of Wonder Lake, Ill., a suburb of Chicago and Naval Medical Center San Diego's (NMCS D) Sailor of the Year (SOY) for 2013, was recently selected as the SOY for Navy Medicine West (NMW), enduring a rigorous interview process among 12 other SOYs vying for the title from around the region. NMW consists of 10 Military Treatment Facilities and two Naval Dental Centers spanning the Western Pacific from California to Japan.

Reeves is, by all accounts, an engaging leader who shows concern for the Sailors under her charge and motivates them to take pride in their respective roles at NMCS D. "I get out there to try to get to know my Sailors," said Reeves, NMCS D's Military Health Center leading petty officer and Independent Duty Corpsman program administrator. "I take an interest in my junior Sailors military careers and personal lives to ensure they are happy."

Reeves makes it a priority to get out of the office and get to know the hospital corpsmen under her charge.

"I'd say I'm a leader who doesn't remain behind the desk," said Reeves. "I try to get out there within



Navy doctors learn how hyperbaric oxygen therapy treats more than decompression sickness

PORTSMOUTH, Va. — Medical practitioners learned how clinical hyperbaric oxygen therapy (HBOT) can treat medical conditions during a seminar Dec. 11 Naval Medical Center Portsmouth, Va.

The seminar presented by Capt. Bruce A. Cohen, force surgeon at Navy Expeditionary Combat Command (NECC), covered the history of the hyperbaric chamber as well as how oxygen therapy is being used in medical facilities.


Hyperbaric oxygen therapy is a well-established treatment for decompression sickness, a hazard of scuba diving. The therapy is also being used to treat other medical conditions including serious infections, bubbles of air in blood vessels, carbon monoxide poisoning, and wounds that won't heal.

"For diving emergencies, decompression illness, and air gas embolism, this is primary therapy," said Cohen. "For everything else, it is adjunct therapy."

A hyperbaric chamber is a sealed cylindrical chamber that increases the amount of oxygen blood can carry; the increase in blood oxygen promotes healing and fights infection.

"It hyper-oxygenizes the plasma," said Cohen. "The plasma surrounds the tissues and the organs so they can live. This is one of the reasons why in compression injuries, and similar injuries, this is a really good deal. It's not the blood supply we're concerned about, it's about bathing the tissue in oxygen."

"I have a select handful of patients that have used the hyperbaric chamber," said Lt. Craig Folsom, Medical

Officer for Coastal Riverine Group (CORIVGRU) 2.

There have been cases in which every treatment has failed. The patient was then referred to receive HBOT which resulted in successful treatment, Folsom said.

HBOT is approved by the Oxygen Therapy Committee of the Undersea and Hyperbaric Medical Society and has few complications. The most common

is the inability to equalize pressure in the middle ear which results in barotraumas.

Hyperbaric air therapy originated in 1662 by a British Clergyman who used organ billows and valves to control the flow of air in a sealed chamber. In 1885, recompression therapy was first used on Hudson Tunnel caisson workers, reducing worker mortality rate from 25 percent to 1.6 percent.

After years of practice and progress, the Undersea Medical Society was founded in 1967 by six U.S. Navy diving and submarine medical officers. This added legitimacy to HBOT which led to training and certification programs.

Currently, the Navy owns two fixed chambers to support local diving operations at Joint Expeditionary Base Little Creek-Fort Story in Virginia Beach, Va., and Naval Station Norfolk in Norfolk, Va.

The chambers are used to treat Navy divers as well as participate in the types of adjunct therapy that Cohen presented during the seminar.

The goal of the seminar, said Cohen, was to bring the current indications and applications of HBOT to the area medical professionals.

"I hope it will broaden their knowledge as they consider all treatment modalities for any given condition," said Cohen.

Residency program to share information

PENSACOLA, Fla. — Naval Hospital Pensacola's Family Medicine Residency Program was recently included in a new online database of professional training programs created by the Patient-Centered Primary Care Collaborative.

The hospital is the only Military Treatment Facility to be included in the database, which identifies innovative primary care training programs throughout the United States.

The PCPCC, which was started in 2006, works to advance an effective and efficient health system with a strong foundation of primary care and a patient-centered medical home model. The database is managed by the PCPCC's Education and Training Task Force and includes 100 programs that support students, residents and health professionals deliver primary care that is patient-centered and collaborative across multiple disciplines including nursing, social work, behavior health and more.

Naval Hospital Pensacola's Family Medicine Residency Program was the first program in the Navy to implement a patient-centered medical home model, known as Medical Home Port, into its residency curriculum.

"I thought it was important to share how residents are taught patient-centered care because we have an established curriculum here around Medical Home Port," said Lt. Kevin Bernstein, a chief resident, NHP.

Bernstein led the initiative to include NHP in the database and spent many hours submitting information about the residency program to PCPCC.

"We are training people within a successful model here," said Bernstein. "That model is good for civilian hospitals to use as well as Military Treatment Facilities."

Sharing of information and successful models is the basis of the database, which is open to everyone at www.pcpcc.org/training. The database is searchable and includes detailed information on existing training programs to include formal curricula, educational components and core competencies that support team-based care delivery like Medical Home Port.

The news of the inclusion on PCPCC's database came at the same time it was announced that NHP's Family Medicine Residency Program will be dissolving by 2016. Despite this news, Bernstein, along with his fellow residents, can take pride in knowing they learned patient-centered care at one of the most successful Medical Home Port programs in the Navy.

"I am proud to be part of this program," said Bernstein, who will graduate next summer. "We [all of the residents] believe that until the residency program is closed for good, residents here will receive the training to be the best doctors to operate within the Medical Home Port model."

the command so I have knowledge of different programs offered in the Navy. It makes me sure I know what to offer my junior Sailors.”

Another leadership trait which impressed her superiors was Reeves' ability to organize and build a cohesive workforce.

“It was quickly evident that she had the pulse of the clinic and knew each Sailor,” said Chief Hospital Corpsman Jeremy L. Simon, leading chief petty officer, Naval Branch Health

Clinic, Marine Corps Air Station Miramar. “She communicated clear expectations, trained and motivated her Sailors to form a solid team then led them to success.”

When Reeves initially learned she had won NMW's Sailor of the Year, she was in a state of shock.

“I was in disbelief. And happy I could bring this title back to the hospital,” she said.

Reeves enlisted when she was 18 years old. Both her grandfathers were in the Navy, so she decided to continue the legacy of serving as a Sailor in her family.

“I wanted to carry on the tradition of my grandfathers,” said Reeves.

The event that led Reeves to serve her country as a hospital corpsman remains seared in her memory; In 1990, she was at the Road America Raceway in Wisconsin watching her father race an MG Midget racecar.

“I was sitting with my brother on the bridge that went over one of the straightaways,” said Reeves. “My dad's car didn't pass by. We noticed again it didn't pass by.”

A yellow flag was waved, indicating caution. Then, a black flag, signifying a particular car is in distress and must pull off the track.

“My brother and I knew it had to have been my father since we didn't see his car,” said Reeves.

A ThedaStar Air Medical transport team was summoned and a helicopter evacuated her father, who had been in a collision, to the Theda Clark Medical Center in Neenah, Wis., about 90 minutes away. Reeves' father was unresponsive and hooked up to life support by the crew. During the ordeal, his heart stopped twice, and both times he was resuscitated.

While Reeves' father was in the emergency room, the rescue crew took Reeves and her brother to their helicopter and showed them its inner workings.

“They let us sit in the pilot seats and take pictures,” she said.

The medical knowledge displayed by the ThedaStar Air Medical team and their ability to bring her father back to life after his heart had stopped left a deep impression on her. It led to her decision to become a hospital corpsman in order to help others in the same manner.

“I wanted to do for others what the ThedaStar crew had done for my father,” said Reeves.

In addition to her dependable leadership and unwavering conviction to be a hospital corpsman, Reeves appreciates the camaraderie she has experienced with other hospital corpsmen.

“It's a tight-knit community, especially at NMCS D,” said Reeves. “We have honor in treating patients — making sure they are fully recovered.”

Reeves has been in the Navy for 16 years and is married to an Aircrew Survival Equipmentman with two children.

She has completed tours on the USS John C. Stennis (CVN 74), USS John F. Kennedy (CV 67) and USS Eisenhower (CVN 69).

Reeves also was an instructor at Naval Survival Training Institute — Aviation Survival Training Center in Pensacola, Fla., where she taught pilots and aircrew water and aviation survival techniques. In addition, she attended Independent Duty Corpsman “C” school in San Diego where she graduated with honors.

She is currently a senior at George Washington University and is studying for a Bachelor of Arts degree in Clinical Health Sciences. In her free time, Reeves enjoys running half marathons. In 2012, she completed the Silver Strand Half Marathon (13.1 miles) which stretched from Coronado to Imperial Beach (San Diego County).



NMCSD Hospital Corpsman Hero

SAN DIEGO — Often when we drive by an accident, most of us slow down to see what has happened. Rarely, though, does someone get out of their car and actually take action to provide assistance. But that is exactly what Hospital Corpsman 3rd Class Justin Cortes, assigned to Naval Medical Center San

Diego's (NMCSD) Dental department, did.

Cortes was enjoying a quiet night with his wife Andrea when fate dropped in and gave him the chance to make a difference in someone else's life.

"We were getting ready to go to bed that night, it was around 11 p.m. I was nine months pregnant and I hadn't had any (pregnancy food) cravings up until that point," said Andrea. "I wanted tacos. When I told Justin he replied,

'Seriously, you want tacos right now? Awesome!'"

It was a seemingly routine night followed by late night munchies. Cortes and his wife were making their way back home, only three blocks from their favorite local taco shop in Chula Vista, Calif., when they saw it.

"It was foggy and looked smoky; then we saw the wreck," said Andrea. "There were automobiles just driving by this car on fire, just like it was normal."

In the midst of haze, confusion and dismissal by other cars Cortes took

action.

"My wife and I noticed the smoke coming from the car. I told my wife I had to do something. I got out of the car and noticed no other immediate dangers," said Justin. "Then I pulled the driver away from the wreckage with fire coming from the car's engine."

Everything Cortes had learned at Navy Hospital Corps School, field medicine training at Marine Corps Air Station Camp Pendleton, and his emergency responders training that he had learned at Naval Hospital Twentynine Palms kicked in as he acted to save a life. It brought him the courage and leadership he needed for that moment.

"I assessed the scene and used the Fleet Marine Force's nine general rules of first aid," said Cortes. "I performed the head-to-toe assessment and the driver only had (a few) compound fractures and I held a C-spine hold, keeping his head still, in line with his spine to prevent further injury and even paralysis."

Cortes remembered and executed his training without hesitation.

"We had left our cell phones at home since the taco shop was only a few blocks away, so I left Justin to go get them," said Andrea. "When I got back to give Justin his cell, there were five people just standing around him, but no one was helping."

Then there was another chance for Cortes to put his Navy Medicine training to good use.

“Some random guy out of nowhere comes by and says he had a fire extinguisher,” said Andrea. “So Justin says, ‘Cool! Put the fire out.’ The guy tells Justin that he doesn’t know how to use it. So Justin, while still holding onto the driver, instructed the guy on how to use the fire extinguisher.”

In the midst of holding the car wreck victim and awaiting the arrival of the police and paramedics, Cortes was able to maintain control and prevent further damage.

Cortes was featured on a breaking news segment with San Diego’s ABC Channel 10 News.

“When the cops arrived I asked if they needed me to stay any longer and they responded that they had the situation under control,” said Cortes. “Then I went home and had some tacos.”

The tired father-to-be went back to work the next morning as usual and never mentioned anything about the situation until he was asked about it from his co-worker who happened to see the news story that morning.

That next day, Oct.30, Andrea went into labor and Cortes was a proud father of a baby girl. Cortes’s Chief Hospital Corpsman David McCarter calls him aside to tell him Commander, Naval Medical Center San Diego (NMCS) and Navy Medicine West would like to congratulate him on his heroic efforts.

Standing in front of his NMCS chain of command, Cortes humbly smiled, saying few words. He was applauded by his superiors for his actions, and was given the Admiral’s personal command coin.
