## TRICARE TIPS HELP ALLEVIATE STRESS DURING A PERMANENT CHANGE OF STATION

FALLS CHURCH, Va. — 'Tis the season. The moving season, that is. Many military families plan permanent change of station (PCS) moves during the summer. And with all of the moving-related tasks that Prime and Prime Remote service members and their families must accomplish, TRICARE wants to ensure a smooth transition of their health-care benefits as well.

For customized information about moving with TRICARE, visit the benefit information portal at <http://www.tricare.mil> and select status, country, zip code and TRICARE plan. There will also be contact information for dental coverage and regional managed care support contractors (MCSCs) on "your profile" page.

Each TRICARE plan has its own individual requirements and beneficiaries are encouraged to investigate TRICARE options in their new location prior to a PCS. There are a few things TRICARE Prime and Prime Remote active duty and family member enrollees can do to make a move easier before, during and after a PCS.

- Refill prescriptions and obtain routine medical care before the move if possible.
- For valuable information about routine, urgent or emergency care while traveling, download and print the handy "Traveling with TRICARE Prime" flyer found in the publications section of <http://www.tricare.mil>, direct link at <http://www.tricare.mil/tricaresmart/product.aspx?id=590&CID=0&RID=1>
- Active duty service members need to coordinate their Prime or Prime Remote enrollment with their new duty station.
- Active duty family members generally should not make changes to their Prime enrollment until they reach their new location.
- If moving within the same region, select a Primary Care Manager (PCM) and submit a TRICARE Prime Enrollment Application and PCM Change Form (DD Form 2876). If moving to a new region, submit the form to the new regional contractor.
- If moving overseas, TRICARE reminds service members to ensure their families are command-sponsored for enrollment in Overseas Prime.

## Illinois soldier serves in specialized service in the Army

FORT IRWIN, Calif. – At first glance, the son of a Machesney Park couple looks nothing like what you'd expect of an American soldier.

He wears long, loose-fitting Arab clothing, a scarf-like head cover, grows facial hair mid lives in the desert in a small Arab village. He stands with Iraqi natives as Arabic calls to prayer can be heard over loud speakers.

Army Spec. Paul A. Anderson, son of Paula and Gary Anderson Sr., of Machesney Park, is a highly specialized American soldier living in the Mojave Desert as an Arab for the exclusive benefit of other soldiers who are preparing for duty in Iraq.

Anderson and the 1,300 "opposing forces" from the 11th Armored Cavalry Regiment, along with 250 Arab-speaking Iraqis, test and challenge soldiers for the likely situations they'll face in the war zone.

"Our main focus is to make sure the soldiers and units that come to the National Training Center leave prepared and more educated about what to expect in Iraq. We dress as the people in Iraq do and learn to speak the language to make the training as real as possible," said Anderson, a 1992 graduate of Rockford East High School.


"As the soldiers patrol the towns and roads, we are engaging them sometimes as harmless unarmed regular people and sometimes as terrorists."

Hollywood makeup artists use their industry's most convincing fake blood on amputee actors here to add to the realism of simulated roadside bomb attacks by role-playing enemy insurgents.

Anderson takes his Arab acting seriously with the goal of providing learned experiences that could help save American lives in Iraq.

"Our most important task is to make sure the soldiers get the feel of being in Iraq, from the dress and language to the layout of the towns. If we fail here, they will not be properly trained to fight in Iraq.

Another goal is to educate the troops coming through that not all Arabs are terrorists, to make sure

we begin to strengthen our relations as well as stop the terrorists," said Anderson.



is well suited to duplicate the natural environment in Iraq. Situated near Death Valley, the center has 1,200 square miles of nothing but desert wilderness where approximately a dozen simulated Arab villages have been built.

Each village has a different look and feel, providing different situations to learn from for the soldier's who will soon be walking village streets in Iraq.

"Being in the middle of the desert, this place gives the feel and look of being in the Middle East. The villages here are built up and named to be as real as possible," said Anderson.

For the moment, Anderson will work as an Arab civilian or enemy combatant, but he has a traditional Army background. He joined the Army in 2004 and has served at Fort Lewis, Wash., and with a field artillery unit at Camp Casey, South Korea. His regular Army military occupational specialty is as a food service specialist.

At first glance Anderson's family or friends may not recognize him in his Arab wear, but his efforts as an actor are likely to help save lives of fellow American soldiers to the war Zone.

# Capt. Morro becomes first Nurse Corps Officer to lead Naval Hospital Pensacola Command

PENSACOLA, Fla. — Captain MaryAlice Morro has become the first Navy Nurse Corps Officer to take the top leadership role in the 182-year history of Naval Hospital Pensacola. Capt. Morro, who is the 72nd commanding officer, relieved Capt. (Dr.) Kevin Berry — who earned a third Legion of Merit award — in a June 17 change of command here at the National Museum of Naval Aviation on the 110th anniversary of the Navy Hospital Corps.

Guest of honor, Rear Admiral (Lower Half) Matthew L. Nathan, head of Navy Medicine East and Naval Medical Center Portsmouth, Va. — and former commander of the Pensacola hospital — praised both officers' dedication and professionalism; and pointed to the "challenges ahead" that remain for each.

NH Pensacola continues to be a "test bed for Navy Medicine," the admiral said. "And there is no other leader more committed ... and vocal" than Capt. Berry.

"I know, because he's in my ear all the time" suggesting ways to how Navy Medicine can better take care of its service members and families. "He has forced the rest of us to keep up."

The admiral told a standing-room only crowd that Capt. Morro has a "tremendous pedigree" along with a strong clinical and administrative background that has taken her all across the globe. "She will hit the ground running" as the hospital's commander.

"You're coming to a community that embraces the military," the admiral told the in-coming commander. "And, there is not any place in the world where this 'love-love relationship' is any greater."

Prior to arriving in Pensacola, Capt. Morro, a native of Drexel Hill, Pa., was executive officer of NH Lemoore, Calif.

Among some of her outside-of-the-states duty stations included: NH Rota, Spain; St. Mawgan, United Kingdom; NH Yokosuka, Japan; and with the hospital ship USNS Comfort in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom.

In Capt. Berry's parting words for the hospital command and community, he spoke to defending the individual (inalienable) rights of the United States' Declaration of Independence: "Life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness."

Those freedoms aren't free. Throughout history people have chosen to serve the Armed Forces of the United States, he began.

There are 2,100 people in the NH Pensacola command; and more than 1,100 have deployed in support of the war on terror — sometimes more than once while serving with the Army and Marines. "More corpsmen serve with the Marine Corps" (10,000) than there are on Navy ships (or in hospitals), he said.

Navy Medicine personnel have to continue to be "ready personally, professionally and spiritually" when the call comes to deploy, either into a combat theater or on a humanitarian mission, in support of the nation, he

continued

"Forty percent of those who put on a uniform are our families," said Capt. Berry recalling treating a dependent family member at Bremerton years ago who is now a Hospital Corpsman.

Then, there are those who served in years past, such as some of the hospital's Red Cross volunteers:

- Francis Emond — a Pearl Harbor attack survivor attached to the Battleship Pennsylvania — who at age 90, not the oldest volunteer, has served Navy families in retirement for more than eight years as a volunteer.

- John Zeigler, a World War II combat infantryman who was a member of the MARS Task Force that opened the 'Burma Road' in 1944, served 35 years in the Army, Air Force and as a Defense civilian; and has been a volunteer for more than 18 years.

Both Rear Adm. Nathan and Capt. Berry will have new assignments this summer.

Capt. Berry will be part of the joint service team that will direct the merger in Bethesda of the Army's Walter Reed Army Medical Center and the NNMIC.

That's one of those good news, bad news stories, the admiral pointed out.

"The good news is that Kevin's going up to oversee the Army-Navy integration," the admiral dead-panned, but "the bad is that Kevin's going up to oversee the Army-Navy integration!"

"He learned to speak Army" when he was assigned to the Army's Tripler Medical Center in Hawaii prior to taking the commander's post in Pensacola, continued Rear Adm. Nathan.

"I use to laugh at that" Army-Navy merger task force position, said the admiral, "until the (Navy) Surgeon General told me I was going to command the medical center in Bethesda."




