## MILITARY VETS CAN HEAL WOUNDS FASTER WITH NEW DRESSING TECHNOLOGY

SANTA CLARA, CA — Military veterans may well get more wounds, than the average population due to that fact that, according to the U.S. Department of Veteran Affairs, around 25 percent of military veteran patients have diabetes. This is compared to around 8 percent of the adult population as a whole. Diabetes, according to the National Institutes of Health, compromises skin integrity, making people more susceptible to getting wounds. # NMCS D's CivFIT class provides cross training to civilian personnel

SAN DIEGO — Always on the lookout to enhance the health and well-being of its employees, Naval Medical Center San Diego (NMCS D) offers a weekly cross-training fitness program called "CivFIT" to civilian employees. "The CivFIT cross-training program is designed to help strengthen and improve our employees' health and wellness," said Joshua Peters, a CivFIT instructor and Health and Fitness coordinator for NMCS D's Health and Wellness Department.

The class is a revolving six-week program that includes Total Body Resistance Exercise (TRX®) training, gravity fitness, core exercises, and yoga. "The idea for the class came from NMCS D's command leadership," said Peters. "Since the Health and Wellness Department's Command Fitness Program has provided excellent preventive and restorative care for our Active Duty, the leadership wanted to extend that same service to our civil service staff."

Since June 2013, the CivFIT program has been encouraging NMCS D civilians to engage in physical activity as a way to feel better and foster an active lifestyle to counter the sedentary environment often synonymous with the workplace.

"Research has shown that physical fitness is one of the most effective disease prevention factors reducing risk of cardiovascular disease, obesity, and depression, while improving stamina and strength," said Peters. "This equates to less doctor visits for the employee, bringing down medical costs, and creates a happier, more productive work environment."

Hank Sullivan, CivFIT instructor and fitness specialist for NMCS D's Morale,

Welfare, and Recreation Department, also believes the program helps to produce a more attentive, efficient civilian staff.

"It's a way to get people out of the office or work environment to get a workout in the middle of their workday," said Sullivan. "It makes them more alert, more productive the rest of their day, and creates a healthier, stronger workforce."

CivFIT offers a welcome break from

the monotony of office work by giving NMCS D civilians an outlet to physically push themselves while trying revolutionary training exercises.

"I am glad I got exposed to some different workouts and many of my coworkers around me have incorporated it into their routines," said Michele Litkenhaus, Health Systems specialist at NMCS D's Tricare Operations Department. "Whenever I work out, even semi-regularly, I feel better and

focus better."

The program includes a variety of exercise styles including Pilates, Gravity, suspension training, yoga, cardio core, and outdoor circuit training.

"After the six week program, the participant has had an opportunity to improve on their mobility, stability, strength, and endurance," said Peters.

CivFIT instructors have various ways of motivating class attendees.

"I like to keep it positive all the time," said Sullivan. "People need to know if they come in for a workout, they're making a real change for the better in their life."

CivFIT instructors strive to instill the mentality that it is always possible for a person to fit a workout into his or her day.

"It could be as simple as walking from one corner of the office to another," said Sullivan. "People need to incorporate as much activity into their day as possible."

NMCS D's CivFIT program benefits its civilian employees in numerous ways. Participating in physical programs is shown to help keep blood sugar under control, lower blood pressure, lift spirits, decreases anxiety, and prevent the onset of cancers, according to center for disease control's website (CDC.gov).

CivFIT is a six-week program offered by NMCS D Health and Wellness Department eight times per year with no more than 12 participants per class.

# Fort Drum soldiers outfitted with TCAPS

FORT DRUM, New York — As early as 2012, The Department of Defense has announced plans of integrating technologically sophisticated, yet tactical, hearing protection devices for Soldiers currently engaged in overseas combat operations and local training exercises. The Tactical Communication and Protective System or TCAPS, has generated a lot of talk amongst Soldiers in Fort Bliss, Texas; Aberdeen Proving Grounds, Maryland; Fort Campbell, Kentucky, and now here.

According to Capt. Jennifer Noetzel, audiology chief, Fort Drum, NY hearing program, the Army's focus with the TCAPS is to minimize training and battlefield related hearing loss, while improving overall situational awareness, increased mission effectiveness, safety and survivability.

"I'm excited to finally see the TCAPS here in Fort Drum, and pleased to see the Soldiers taking to the devices naturally" said Noetzel.

The Florence, Kentucky native has been serving four years, and although the young Captain has not yet deployed, she admits to having seen and treated a lot of hearing loss cases from redeployed troops as she is the chief audi-

ologist on Fort Drum.

"Soldiers have told me quite openly, the main reason they refused to wear, or partially wear, hearing protection while out on a mission was because it hindered their overall situational awareness. The old foam hearing plugs and other cumbersome devices, while effective in protecting hearing, denied Soldiers the ability to clearly hear commands and possible enemy or friendly movement. Mixed with pulling security, it's a bad combination that can lead to injury or loss of life" Noetzel said.

According to an annual benefits report released in 2012 by the Department of Veterans Affairs, the most prevalent service-connected disabilities for veterans receiving federal compensation in 2011 were tinnitus and hearing loss, respectively, followed by PTSD/Post Traumatic Stress Disorder. Furthermore, in fiscal year 2009, approximately \$1.1 billion in disability compensation was paid for these two conditions, and the number continues to rise.

"This device is ten times better than the basic foam ear pro [protection] and head-set we had! I can connect this to my tactical radio, communicate with my Soldiers on ground and higher up, while

still protecting my hearing" said Staff Sgt. Nathaniel D. Burton, Third platoon Sgt., Company Alpha, 1st Battalion, 87 Infantry Regiment, FT. Drum, NY.

Burton, a 12-year veteran in the Infantry and twice deployed in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom, suffered hearing loss due to combat related noises. He admits that in the past, in order to clearly hear his two-way communication devices and Soldiers around him, he had to remove one side of his hearing protection. Now, Burton says he no longer has to put himself at further hearing loss risk because the TCAPS merges well with his medically issued hearing aid and tactical radios mitigating risk.

"I wish this would have been available years ago. The operating instructions are very clear and the system is easy to integrate and adjust to. I especially like the fact that I can use this with or without my gear, at the motor pool or just walking around in a garrison environment. This thing is light weight and awesome!" added Burton.

The TCAPS is the Army program name and accommodates various ear canals in six shapes: standard, slim, large, and short in the three aforementioned sizes. Soldiers can recharge

the TCAPS through solar, Alternating Current with US standard and international plug/ports, and use of vehicle battery to name a few. The TCAPS costs approximately \$2,000.00 per device and comes standard with software, Smartphone, instructional manual, warranty, carrying case and other supporting elements.

According to Noetzel, the system not only works to preserve, protect, and enhance hearing, the TCAP is designed to completely take over and shut out unexpected and excruciatingly loud noises, noises such as explosions or overhead flying objects, while simultaneously maintaining communication fidelity.

In total, approximately 1,269 Soldiers were screened, sized, outfitted, and trained. First Brigade Combat Team were issued a total of 2000 TCAPS units. Noetzel projects approximately 4,000 TCAPS units will be in circulation throughout Fort Drum with Second Brigade Combat Team scheduled for training on the TCAPS in as early as April.

# Medical Group welcomes new commander

KEESLER AIR FORCE BASE, Miss. — The “Dragon Medics” welcomed their new leader as Col. (Dr.) Thomas Harrell assumed command of the 81st Medical Group from Brig. Gen. (Dr.) Kory Cornum during a change of command ceremony conducted in Keesler Medical Center’s Don Wylie Auditorium. Brig. Gen. Patrick Higby, 81st Training Wing commander, was presiding officer.

Harrell comes to Keesler Air Force Base from Joint Base Elmendorf-Richardson, Alaska, where he commanded the Department of Defense/Veterans Affairs Joint Venture Hospital and also served as the Alaskan Command command surgeon. Cornum has been reassigned to Scott AFB, Ill., as Air Mobility Command command surgeon.

In addition to commanding the medi-

cal group and Keesler Medical Center, the colonel also serves as the senior market manager for TRICARE’s Gulf Coast Multi-Service Market, which includes five military medical facilities stretching from Mobile, Ala., to New Orleans and he is a co-lead for the Biloxi DoD/VA joint venture centers of excellence initiative.

As commander, Harrell is responsible for the direct delivery of health care at Keesler Medical Center and its clinics while coordinating the health care for all Joint Service warfighters, military retirees and their family members along the Gulf Coast. He ensures that all Keesler medics are ready for both combat missions and humanitarian medical responses. He directs five graduate medical education programs, eight enlisted training programs and a clinical research laboratory. He leads almost 1,700 health-care professionals and manages a local budget of almost \$90 million. In addition, Colonel

Harrell is the federal coordinator for the Gulf Coast National Disaster Medical System.

The colonel received an Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps Pre-Health Profession Scholarship, graduating from the University of South Florida in 1988 and was commissioned as a second lieutenant. He was conferred a doctor of medicine degree from the University of South Florida College of Medicine in 1992 and completed residency training in internal medicine at Wright-Patterson AFB, Ohio, Medical Center in 1995 followed by a sponsored fellowship in cardiology and electrophysiology at the University of Colorado Health Sciences Center in Denver, completing his training in 1998.

Harrell reported for active duty at Nellis AFB, Nev., in 1998 as the chief of the Cardiopulmonary Department at Mike O’Callaghan Federal Hospital, later becoming the chief of medical services. At Brooks City-Base, Texas,

he served as the USAF Aeromedical Consult Service cardiologist and subsequently as the first chief of the Medical Flight Screening Branch. He served an operational tour as the chief of aeromedical services for the 435th MDG, Ramstein Air Base, Germany, prior to assuming inaugural command of the surgical operations squadron at Royal Air Force Lakenheath, England.

Leaving England, Harrell became the deputy director of Air Force Medical Services at the Air Force Medical Operations Agency, Lackland-Kelly AFB, Texas. He completed a master of science degree in strategic study with academic distinction as class president of the Air War College at Maxwell AFB, Ala., before his assignment to Alaska.

The colonel is a senior flight surgeon with experience in a variety of aircraft required to execute both the United States Air Force’s combat and humanitarian missions.

## Medical Center selected for new treatment procedure

KEESLER AIR FORCE BASE, Miss. — Keesler Medical Center is one of only 25 medical treatment facilities in the nation selected as a site for a new coronary artery disease (CAD) treatment procedure.

The “Diamondback 360® Coronary Orbital Atherectomy System” (OAS) uses a diamond-tipped orbiting drill that sands away calcium in severely-calcified coronary arteries, enabling stent placement. As the crown rotates and orbit increases, centrifugal force presses the crown against the lesion, reducing arterial calcium, while healthy tissue flexes away.

The Cardiac Catheterization Lab staff here performed their first OAS procedure March 12, said Lt. Col. (Dr.) Steve Kindsvater, commander of the 81st Medical Operations Squadron Cardiovascular/Pulmonary Flight,

“The company (St. Paul, Minn.-based Cardiovascular Systems, Inc.) selected a limited number of ‘centers of excellence’ around the U.S. as platforms to launch the treatment,” Kindsvater explained. “Keesler Medical Center is proud to be able to offer this new treatment to our military and VA beneficiaries.”

Information provided by the company noted OAS “uses a patented combination of differential sanding and centrifugal force to reduce arterial calcium that can cause complications when treating CAD, a life-threatening condition. Arterial calcium is a common occurrence and can lead to significant complications, with moderate to severe arterial calcium present in nearly 40 percent of patients undergoing stent procedures in the U.S.”

“Keesler Medical Center is at the leading edge of innovative cardiac care, and selected the revolutionary technology based on studies of its safety and effectiveness in treating severely calcified coronary lesions,” Kindsvater said. “The Diamondback 360 Coronary OAS provides our patients undergoing stenting with the first evidence-based option approved by the FDA (Food and Drug Administration) for this difficult-to-treat patient population.”

Kindsvater noted, “Coronary artery disease is a life-threatening condition and leading cause of death in men and women in the United States. CAD occurs when a fatty material - plaque - builds up on the walls of arteries that supply blood to the heart. The plaque buildup causes the arteries to harden and narrow (atherosclerosis), reducing blood flow. The risk of CAD increases if a person has one or more of the following: high blood pressure, abnormal cholesterol levels, diabetes or family history of early heart disease.”

According to the American Heart Association, 16.3 million people in the United States have been diagnosed with CAD, the most common form of heart disease that claims more than 600,000 lives annually. Significant calcium contributes to poor outcomes and higher treatment costs in coronary interventions when traditional therapies are used, including a significantly higher occurrence of death and major adverse cardiac events.
