

NEW SERVICE ANNOUNCED FOR WOUNDED WARRIORS, FAMILIES AND CAREGIVERS

DoD announced recently that the Military OneSource service has established a Wounded Warrior Resource Center telephone number and e-mail address for service members and their families, if they have concerns or other difficulties during their recovery process.

Service members and their family members can now call (800) 342-9647 or e-mail wwrc@military-onesource.com 24/7 to request support. Assistance provided by the resource center will not replace the specialized wounded warrior programs established by each of the military services, but it will offer another avenue of assistance for military facilities, health care services, and/or benefits information.

"The department is committed to aggressively addressing the needs of our service members and their families," said Secretary of Defense Robert M. Gates.

Specially trained consultants will ensure consistent, quality customer-centric support. The consultants will identify the appropriate "warm hand-off" to either a military service or federal agency with authority to resolve the matter. The resource center consultant will maintain communication with the caller until the issue or concern is resolved.

"The term 'wounded warrior' encompasses the entire population of wounded, ill and injured service members and veterans," said Principal Deputy Under Secretary of Defense for Personnel and Readiness Michael L. Dominguez.

The Wounded Warrior Resource Center meets the requirements of Section 1616 of the "National Defense Authorization Act Fiscal Year 2008" for a centralized number and ensures wounded families and caregivers have a number to call at any time.



A Proclamation by the President of the United States of America

America remains inspired by the countless acts of kindness and sacrifice we saw that day -- fearless rescuers who rushed toward danger, a beloved priest who died helping others, two office workers who carried a disabled person 68 floors to safety.

We also pray for the safety and success of the members of our Armed Forces now serving freedom's cause. We seek God's grace on their families, and commit to Heaven's care those brave men and women He has called home.

We ask the Almighty to watch over America and pray for His providence and continued blessings on our country. May He always guide the United States of

America.

As we defend our country against its enemies, we pray for help in protecting the gift of freedom from those who seek to destroy it, and we ask the Almighty to strengthen all those securing liberty on distant shores.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, GEORGE W. BUSH, President of the United States of America, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the United States, do hereby proclaim Friday, September 5, through Sunday, September 7, 2008, as National Days of Prayer and Remembrance. I ask that the people of the United States and their places of worship mark these National Days of Prayer and Remembrance with memorial services, the ringing of bells, and evening candlelight remembrance vigils. I also invite all people across the world to share in these Days of Prayer and Remembrance.

Full video Urodynamics Suite makes Naval Hospital a 'unique' facility

Naval Hospital Pensacola has made major leaps recently in order to provide the most up-to-date and least painful, minimally-invasive urologic procedures available today; and is the only medical facility in the area to have a full Video Urodynamics Suite to aid in the diagnosis and treatment of incontinence, pelvic organ and bladder dysfunction.

"We are unique," said Navy Urologist Lt. Cmdr. Timothy Redden, being the "only facility in the immediate area to have a full Video Urodynamics Suite" that helps in the diagnosis and treatment of a wide variety of urologic disorders.

NH Pensacola now offers minimally-invasive advance laparoscopic urologic

procedures to treat benign and malignant diseases; and provides the "newest minimally-invasive treatment" for female pelvic floor dysfunction, incontinence and prolapse, said Dr. Redden.

Within the next couple of months, Navy urologists - at civilian partner Baptist Hospital Pensacola - will be performing robot-assisted, minimally-invasive radical prostatectomy in the treatment of prostate cancer, he continued.

The robot-assisted treatment for prostate cancer removes the prostate and lymphatic tissue via several, less than one-half inch incisions using a DaVinci robotic system from intuitive surgery.

Navy Urologists, Kevin Mahaffey and Redden, will be performing the surgeries for Department of Defense-eligible patients at Baptist Hospital.

This "new beginning" for NH Pensacola Urology, and the co-venture between the Veterans Administration

and Defense Department with the soon-to-open 'Joint Ambulatory Care Center' (JACC), will "allow the Navy Medicine facility to treat VA-eligible veterans as well as active duty and retired DoD members and their families," said Redden.

The joint venture will eliminate the

need for some VA patients to have to travel long distances for treatment.

The minimally invasive surgeries allow for shorter hospital stays, shorter recovery, less pain and a return to work sooner than traditional open surgery, the urologist continued.

Patients who have been deferred

to the TRICARE network, and who may want to avail themselves of these new procedures, should inquire with the Urology Department (telephone: 505-6266) before going elsewhere for treatment when they may well be able to have it done at NH Pensacola.

Naval Hospital XO earns top healthcare management credential

Captain Paula McClure, executive officer of Naval Hospital Pensacola, recently became a Fellow of the American College of Healthcare Executives (ACHE) -- the nation's leading professional society for healthcare leaders.

The Medical Service Corps officer, who arrived at NH Pensacola in May 2007 to take over the day-to-day operations as Executive Officer and as Commanding Officer of Fleet Hospital Pensacola, is a 1987 graduate of the West Virginia Institute of Technology with a bachelor's degree in Health Services Administration.

"We are very proud of Capt. McClure's accomplishments," said

hospital Commanding Officer Capt. MaryAlice Morro. "There is a lot of work and study that goes into obtaining this certification and this exemplifies her dedication and sustained excellence in executive medicine."

Capt. McClure was commissioned an Ensign in the Medical Service Corps in January 1986 as a Healthcare Administrator. After Naval Officer Indoctrination School at Newport, RI, her first duty station was as the Administrative Officer at Pensacola's Naval Aerospace Medical Institute.

"Because healthcare management ultimately affects the people in our communities, it is critically important to have a standard of excellence pro-

moted by a professional organization, says Dr. Thomas C. Dolan, president and chief executive officer of ACHE.

"By becoming an ACHE Fellow and simultaneously earning board certification, healthcare leaders can show that they are committed to providing high-quality service to their patients and community," he said.

While serving a tour at NH Camp Lejeune, NC, she deployed with the II Marine Expeditionary Force as Commanding Officer, Bravo Surgical Company, Combat Logistics Battalion



2, in the Al Anbar Province of Iraq where she and fellow officers among the first to earn the Fleet Marine Force Warfare Qualification Device.

In 1989, duty took her to then-NH Millington, Tenn., as Head of Operating Management, Personnel Management and Operational Readiness.

Later, she was named Officer in Charge of Branch Medical Clinic Millington with additional adjunct roles in Performance Improvement and Risk Management. Capt. McClure moved on to come a Navy Medical Recruiter at Naval Recruiting District Memphis between 1991-94.

Other overseas tours include duty at then-NH Roosevelt Roads, Puerto Rico; and as Officer in Charge of the Branch Medical Clinic La Maddalena, Italy.

Pensacola Native, Corpsman creates mural to honor fallen at NH Yokosuka

YOKOSUKA, Japan — Naval Hospital Yokosuka Corpsman Youngran Jun, a native of Pensacola, Fla., spends a good deal of her time listening. The petty officer third class spent a month and a half working on a mural that tends to make people stop and at times express their feelings. Her mural is a dedication to all the Navy corpsmen that have been killed during Operation Iraqi Freedom. The 24 sketched faces protected by plexiglass overlook the family practice area of the hospital. Names of 25 other corpsmen killed in the war are listed on the right side. In the middle of the mural is a drawing of the Sailor's Cross, a memorial for sailors killed in combat consisting of a helmet, boots, sandbag and dogtags. In some cases, such as during her visit to the hospital on her day off Tuesday, Jun encounters people who knew one of the corpsmen she sketched on a white wall in pencil. Jun, 23, relishes opportunities like these, when she gets to learn more about those corpsmen. "Either they stand there not saying anything and then they talk to me, or they start crying," she said. Though Jun said she hadn't done much drawing since high school, her master chief asked her to do the mural after seeing her artwork displayed during a Christmas decorating contest last year.

"She'd be here until after midnight working on it ... just incredibly dedicated," said Lt. Cmdr. Teresa Miller, Jun's division officer. Jun spent countless hours on the Internet researching the fallen corpsmen.

Originally the work was to have color, but Jun said that "didn't work out



Force Health Protection and Readiness launches chemical-biological warfare exposures website

FALLS CHURCH, Va. - The Department of Defense Force Health Protection and Readiness Directorate (FHP&R) has launched the Chemical-Biological (CB) Warfare Exposures Web site to provide Service members, veterans, their families and the public with information on the testing of chemical and biological warfare agents from 1942 to 1975. The Web site presents sections on World War II, Project 112/SHAD (Shipboard Hazard and Defense), and the Cold War.

To evaluate the ability of U.S. forces to fight on a chemical and biological battlefield, DoD conducted testing programs. In some programs Service members were present but not test subjects and in other programs they were volunteer human subjects. This testing ended in 1975. DoD has been actively engaged in an extensive search of official records to find the names of veterans who may have been exposed to the chemical or biological agents. DoD plans to complete the search in 2011, but will pursue any leads from veterans or others who may have information.

The Service member names identified by DoD, along with specific exposure information, are provided to the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA). The VA then notifies the individuals of their potential exposure, provides treatment if necessary, and adjudicates any claim for compensation. For privacy reasons, the Web site does not contain the names of the veterans exposed.

because everybody liked the gray and the white, so I just left it in pencil." Miller said reactions to the Pensacola, Fla., native's mural indicates that it was time well spent. Though Jun doesn't know any of the corpsmen she has drawn, Miller said she gets approached regularly by those who knew the fallen "and nods her head, and just shows the respect to the corpsmen on the wall as well as the person that wants to tell their story." Miller said she and other hospital staff have sent pictures home of the mural, expanding its effect well outside of Yokosuka. "I don't know if she really appreciates the impact that it has on people, but I think she's learning," Miller said. The mural has affected Jun, too. She says she is proud to be part of the mural; not just because she created it, "but because of what they did."
