## STUDENT MAKES USU HISTORY BEFORE CLASSES BEGIN

Five years ago, Army Sgt. Julie Bytnar was leading a very different life. Back then, she was a homemaker, living in the suburbs of Chicago while her husband, Bill, earned most of the family's income.

Then, without warning, Bill became very ill after a rare blood-clotting disorder ravaged his body. Over time, his condition deteriorated and Bill could no longer work. Their bills began piling up with no reprieve in sight.

Julie, desperate to keep hope alive, enlisted in the military so she could take care of her husband and young children.

"Although I was eligible for a commission based on my education and work experience, the lead time would have been much longer, and I needed a career right away," she said. "So I enlisted in 2009 at 38 years old and have been learning about the Army from the bottom up ever since."

Although her uniformed career has been short, Julie's military indoctrination was the swift, no-holds-barred kind. After proving herself at garrison duty assignments as a lead healthcare specialist, Julie deployed to Afghanistan in 2011.

"It was an intense experience. I provided a lot of hands-on care to wounded service members and local Afghans, treating everything from minor to life threatening injuries," she said.

Julie's experience in Afghanistan also changed her career focus. Instead of simply providing care, Julie began thinking about the bigger picture and wondering how she could prevent injuries from happening in the first place.

Her curiosity eventually led her to the Uniformed Services University, where she broke ground as the first-ever enlisted service member to be accepted into a graduate-level program.

"Even though I was hopeful, I was still very surprised when I got my acceptance letter from USU," Julie said. "Now I'm working toward a Master of Public Health. I already have a few classes under my belt. They were challenging but I feel confident I'll survive the program. I want to prove to myself and everyone else that I can do this."

Although Julie is still uncertain about her future after graduation, she has a science background and a fondness for research that's pulling her toward a specialization in epidemiology.

It's a difficult track in a rigorous program on a campus full of military officers. Still, Julie's determination is tenacious.

"The past few years have been tough but I'm more confident now than ever before," she said. "I made it through basic training with a bunch of soldiers in their late teens and early 20s. I've gone on dismounted patrols in a warzone and treated some pretty grievous injuries. Now I'm at USU. I feel like there isn't a whole lot I can't do."

# Navy Nurse Corps brings dream to life for ten-year-old

SAN DIEGO — The Navy Nurse Corps Association (NNCA) at Naval Medical Center San Diego (NMCS) made a dream come true for a local Navy family member Friday, Aug. 29.

Mila Van Tine, a 10-year-old diagnosed with neuroblastoma, received un-official orders to report to NMCS as a Navy Nurse. A Navy Working Uniform accompanied her with Lieutenant and Navy Nurse Corps patches, courtesy of the NNCA. She also got a set of scrubs, a hospital ID badge and carried a stethoscope as she made her “rounds.”

Mila’s parents Loraine and Chief (Select) Personnel Specialist Richard A. Van Tine, who is assigned to NMCS, are attempting to present their daughter with as many wishes as they are able as she continues her daily fight against cancer.

The scheduled events of the day included attending a command awards ceremony, where she was presented with an Honorary Navy Nurse Certificate from Commander, Naval Medical Center San Diego and Navy Medicine West, Rear Adm. Bruce L. Gillingham and NMCS Director of Nursing Services, Capt. Kerri S. Pegg, at 8 a.m. After the awards ceremony, she met with Gillingham and Pegg and other command representatives in the command suite conference room before her tour of the hospital beginning with the Pediatrics wards. At approximately 9:30, Mila got some instruction and some hands-on experience being a nurse. After that she participated in a

# Keesler Airman provides a quiet escape for deployed healthcare professionals

BAGRAM AIRFIELD, Afghanistan — “Namaste everyone; the first thing I want you to do is relax and concentrate on your breathing” are among the first words you may hear when participating in an everyday yoga class held in a spacious classroom, glamorous physical fitness club or in the privacy of one’s own living room. But to hear those words among co-workers in the small confines of a hospital waiting area in Afghanistan where an office chair may inhibit you from fully extending yourself in the Warrior Two pose, after having spent three hours in an operating room, then it might mean that much more to you.

Senior Airman Kandie Ibarra, from the the 81st Medical Group at Keesler Air Force Base, Mississippi, is serving her first deployment as a lab technician. Assigned to the 455th Expeditionary Medical Support Squadron, Ibarra created an escape from the busy and sometimes stressful world of the Craig Joint Theater Hospital here.

The hospital has basic services such as dental, out-patient care, flight medicine and optometry, in addition to a very busy trauma section which involves many of the sections within the hospital. Many of these doctors, nurses and lab technicians can be tasked with preserving a life at any given time.

How each of them deals with it varies--some may pray, some may block it out entirely and move on to the next surgery or daily checkup--but for Ibarra and her co-workers, yoga offers that quiet escape to a calm and relaxed environment.

“Yoga provides me a quiet place to go and get away from the stresses of the day,” said Ibarra, a resident of Blackfoot, Idaho. “As a lab technician, our section responds to traumas several times a week and we see the results of the war first hand. Everyone handles stress differently. What we do can affect people differently.”

Ibarra, along with four other lab techs and an officer-in-charge, make up the blood bank team for the hospital. They run Operation Enduring Freedom’s busiest blood bank. In July, they matched 488 blood components for 59 wounded ISAF personnel, ran 21,000 tests in support of nine Forward Operating Bases, and teamed with the Blood Support Detachment and Outpatient Clinic to deliver 77 pints of blood for a transfusion for two wounded personnel within two hours.

Ibarra has been practicing yoga for six years, but upon arriving at Bagram, she realized there weren’t any yoga classes. It would have been easy to practice on her own, but she wanted to share her

quiet getaway with others.

She wasn’t certified, so she did some research to see how she could go about sharing yoga, which led her to “Yoga for Vets” and “Mindful Yoga Therapy,” two organizations whose founders were previously in the military and initially started leading yoga classes as uncertified instructors as well.

The two organizations were thrilled of Ibarra’s interest in starting up a yoga class and were eager to help, she said. They donated 22 mats and a few books to get her started. With their help, she was able to share the quiet space yoga has provided her.

“I’ve always wanted to get certified, but coming here I noticed there wasn’t a lot of space for me to practice yoga like I would at the gym or at home,” said Ibarra. “I wanted to create a space that I could do it and kind of share it with other people here.”

Since Ibarra worked in the hospital and many of her co-workers wanted to experience this quiet getaway time

as well, she searched for a place where this could happen. Flight medicine had some space and she was able to acquire the space two nights a week as long as she moved all furniture back in place upon completion of the class.

“I’ve attended the class every night since Senior Airman Ibarra has started it,” said U.S. Air Force Capt. Amanda Eagan, an operating room nurse deployed from Joint Base San Antonio, Texas and native of Brooksville, Florida. “It’s a blessing to have this quiet time to get into yourself and to close your eyes and to feel stress free because that is what’s important here. You need that time to decompress.”

Although the space is confined, having the class in the hospital is a benefit for staff members who participate because when there is an emergency call, personnel can respond in seconds.

During trauma calls, doctors and nurses aren’t the only responders, but representatives from anesthesiology, pharmacy, radiology and the lab must respond as well. Ibarra, as a lab tech, is needed if the patient has lost a lot of blood or requires surgery.

It can be an uneasy feeling when that call comes through the hospital because no one knows at first if it’s a life and death situation.

“When I hear a trauma call, I grab our emergency release blood, plasma and our I-stats for on the spot chemistry results,” said Ibarra. “Once in the trauma bay, the blood tubes must be labeled with patient’s information and we have to make sure everything is labeled correctly. Once the patient arrives, things slow down a bit because we, as lab technicians, are waiting for the blood to be drawn and that’s when I begin to think about the patient. Will they fully recover from their injuries, and how did they end up here?”

After a mass casualty or any type of trauma call, staff members want that

quiet time to unwind and switch to a more relaxed mode or perspective, and the yoga class has done that for a few service members.

“Yoga literally gives me a chance to relax all those muscles and that tension that is within you and you just breathe it away,” added Eagan. “Ibarra just walks you through the poses, she walks you through everything and it allows you to just melt everything away.”

The class typically starts in the dimly lit waiting area of flight medicine, where the chairs are stacked and lined along any available wall. Soft instrumental music plays while Ibarra speaks softly to her brothers and sisters-in-arms as they briefly try to put the stresses of the day behind them. They relax their minds by closing their eyes and practice controlled breathing exercises while seated on their mat with their hands and arms folded in a prayer pose. From here, the class moves into several positions and stretches designed to free the body and spirit.

Namaste, which literally means “I bow to you” according to Yogajournal.com is said at the beginning and the end of a class. It can be viewed as a symbol of gratitude and respect between the teacher and his or her students.

Eagan believes yoga fits within the Air Force Comprehensive Airman Fitness framework of physical, spiritual, mental and social fitness.

“Yoga is not only about learning how to decompress and release that stress, it’s also very physical, and it’s very emotional,” said Eagan.

The CJTH staff isn’t just Airmen, there are a few U.S. Army medical staff members as well, and some of them have also found the class beneficial.

“It’s been a great way to release stress and get your body to loosen up a little bit,” said U.S. Army Spc. Briana Smith, a native of Sugarloaf, Pennsylvania, and a lab tech assigned to the 379th Blood Support Detachment out of Edgemont, Pennsylvania.

Ibarra has shared her yoga experience or quiet escape through 17 classes so far and sometimes is still nervous at the start, but as she continues, it gets easier because she’s among friends.

“I feel like I’m sharing it with a friend as you would do anything that you believe in,” said Ibarra. “If you learn a new routine or workout technique, of course you’re going to do it together, so in a way I’m just sharing and making it available with friends.”

“Lay back and close your eyes with your palms opened toward the ceiling, continue your deep controlled breaths, concentrate on being relaxed and calm,” are the soft-spoken words from Ibarra at the end of her class. “See you next time, Namaste.”

## Keesler medic celebrates weight loss milestone

KEESLER AIR FORCE BASE, Miss. — August 16 was a special anniversary for Courtney Tillman. It marked one year since she began a weight-loss campaign during which, to date, she has shed almost 160 pounds.

Tillman, an Intensive Care Unit monitor technician with the 81st Inpatient Operations Squadron, weighed 355 pounds when she began the ketogenic diet after she had to ask for a seatbelt extension during a trip to Scotland.

It was embarrassing!" she said.

The "keto" diet is a low-carb diet similar to Atkins, but with leaner meats and proteins, Tillman explained.

"For the first couple of months, I just dieted" she said. "Then I did a little bit of walking. I've been in a kick-boxing class the past two or three months and I just started Muay Thai class."

Tillman trains at a local mixed martial arts club.

Describing the reaction of coworkers to her achievement, Tillman commented, "Everyone has been super supportive. Knowing I've had so much support has kept me motivated."

In addition to her improved appearance, she noted, "I'm feeling wonderful! I'm much more active and flexible. I'm able to do things I never thought I could; two weeks ago, I did a back roll for the first time!"

With an ultimate goal of reaching 155 pounds, Tillman will continue her workouts.

"I've been working out two times a week but have increased it to three times," she said.

A native of Mobile, Tillman moved to Biloxi around four years ago, about the time she began working at Keesler Medical Center. She returns to Mobile every two weeks, she said, to visit family.

"Every time my family sees me, they just can't believe my progress" she said. "They notice a huge difference in my appearance."

Tillman commented her mother's side of the family has faced weight issues, noting one aunt has been losing weight while another has been struggling. She has been giving her advice on weight-loss techniques.

She encourages dieters to set realistic goals and not be discouraged if they only take off 1 pound.

"If you look at what a pound of fat looks like...losing 1 pound a week or month all counts!"

# After 40 years of service, Soldier hangs his boots

After serving nearly 40 years, Command Sgt. Maj. Sixto Lopez of Berwyn, Illinois, with Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 404th Maneuver Enhancement Brigade in Chicago, will retire from the Illinois Army National Guard in September.

"My military family is a big family. I feel so honored and proud to serve all of these years," said Lopez. "I am proud to be there for all the Soldiers. I have an open door policy and I feel honored when they come to me. They have been there for me and I have been there for them."

Retired Sgt. William Steele of Chicago, a leg amputee wounded Soldier, who served with Lopez for six years and deployed with him to Afghanistan, remembered his first encounters with Lopez.

"He mentored me and always knew what a good leader looked like," said Steele.

Steele said when he wanted to reclas-

sify to a different military job in preparation for a deployment, Lopez sent him to school and began to mentor him.

"While I was in Walter Reed and even now that I am retired, he continues to be my mentor," said Steele. "We talk or text every week. I know he will always be there for me."

Lopez joined the military at 20 years old in March 1975, as an infantryman with the Troop E, 106th Cavalry in Chicago. In June 1983, he began in the Active Guard Reserve program as the training noncommissioned officer with Company C, 108th Support Battalion in Chicago. He held many positions as he climbed the noncommissioned officer chain, serving as a section chief of a transportation platoon, squad leader, supply sergeant, platoon sergeant, first sergeant, battalion operations sergeant and the sergeant major as the unit operations sergeant.

"The most rewarding positions for me were as a sergeant major and as a command sergeant major," said Lopez. "I was able to get close to the Soldiers and understand their needs. I was able to be a better leader."

From January through July 2002, he deployed to Germany in support of Operation Enduring Freedom. In 2008, he deployed to Afghanistan, where he served as the command sergeant major for the Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 1st Battalion, 178th Infantry in Chicago. During his military career,

Lopez served his country through different missions in Honduras, Ukraine, Panama, Germany, Afghanistan and Botswana.

Lopez was the first of his family to join the military. Only after he joined, his extended family decided to join.

"I was the first one to break the ice," said Lopez. "My daughter served more than 8 years in the Air National Guard and my son served more than 6 years in the Illinois Army National Guard."

Lopez is married to Maria E. Lopez; they have one daughter Vanessa and two sons, Sixto Jr. and Omar.

"I want to thank my wife, Maria, for being there for me," said Lopez. "Without our spouses we cannot do much."

Plans after retirement include finishing his master's degree and finding a part-time job so he does not go crazy from boredom, said Lopez. He also plans to volunteer in his community at the town hall, Veterans of Foreign Wars and the American Legion.

"I am so proud to serve this great nation, the state of Illinois and Army National Guard," said Lopez.

## Medic receives flight training position

She was notified of her selection in February 2014.

But I played college basketball (at Tennessee State University) and completed the Air Force Marathon, so I didn't believe this would be an issue. Once you've been certified, you're half way there."

When Brooks received word that she had been selected, she didn't know how

to feel, she said.

"It's hard to describe," Brooks said, "I was excited and overwhelmed at the same time. I'm really excited and ready to go."


Brooks desire to become a flight nurse was a chance to provide patient care.



by retired Lt. Col. David Shultz, who retired in 2007, with 29 years of Air Force service.


"My interest in military history dates back to the 60s and upon retirement I became curator of the Texas Air Museum in San Antonio," Shultz said.
